



The Municipality of Anchorage Project Management & Engineering Department (MOA PM&E) is planning to upgrade the storm drain system along Camrose Drive and Derby Way (see map on back). Improvements may include:

- New storm drain system
- New asphalt pavement
- New road foundation
- New curb and gutter

MOA PM&E has contracted with CRW Engineering Group, LLC (CRW) to provide preliminary engineering and design services. CRW will evaluate alternatives to improve the drainage and roadways and provide recommendations in a Design Study Report (DSR).

GEOTECHNICAL AND POTHOLE CREWS WILL BE WORKING IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD



Starting in late September, expect to see geotechnical crews along Camrose Drive and Derby Way. They will be drilling within public right-of-way to collect soil and groundwater data. Starting in October there will be a pothole crew confirming utility locations. Thank you in advance for your patience, and please use caution when driving near the crews.

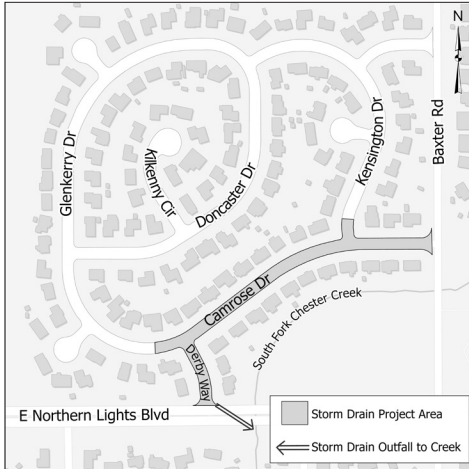
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Camrose Drive Drainage, Project Map



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
